

Registration is free of cost. However, interested applicants are required to obtain a Letter of Approval from the institution.

The Theme of the Programme

The theme of Programme is *Empowering Non-Teaching Staff for Institutional Excellence* which emphasizes the critical role that non-teaching staff play in the smooth functioning and overall success of an educational institution. The training focuses on enhancing skills, motivation, and leadership capabilities to create a more efficient, supportive, and professional work environment.

The following broad sub-themes will be covered across the sessions of the programme:

1. Higher Education Ecosystem of HEIs

Nature and Structure of Higher Education- Role of UGC, AICTE, NMC, and other professional bodies, in providing higher education – Overview: NEP 2020, Accreditation: NAAC, and NBA; Ranking Framework: NIRF. Governance Structure of Universities and Colleges in India

2. Academics

Admissions, Attendance Monitoring, Examination, Evaluation and Results - Noting and Drafting, Curriculum Development, the Pedagogy, the Assessment which includes formative and summative. - Maintenance of Registers and Records, Cocurricular activities such as social work, sports and cultural activities.

3. Establishment matters and UGC Regulations:

Recruitment Rules & Managing Recruitments, Promotion under CAS, Pay Fixation Rules – Enterprise Resource Planning – CCS & Rules: Conduct, Pension, Leave - LTC – Samarth & CU-Chayan Portal – Management: Contract, Construction, Guest House, Hostel, Maintenance etc.

Constitutional Provisions of Reservation – Guidelines for SC/ST/OBC/PWD/EX-SERVICE MEN/EWS, Mandatory committees such as ICC, Grievance redressal, Anti Ragging and SC/ST committees, Vigilance Manual – RTI Acts.

4. Psychology In Workflow

Motivation and Self-Development, Communication Skills – Work Commitment – Professional Competence – Time and Work Management – Ethics and Values, Building intrinsic motivation and cultivating a positive attitude, Stress management techniques for better work-life balance, Leadership and Teamwork.

5. Technology in Workflow

MS Office, Mail merge and Mailing, Working on Synchronous and Asynchronous Modes, Understanding personal goals and their alignment with institutional goals, Digital Governance, Handling Social Media.

6. Finance

Budgeting - Accounts - Public Finance Management System (PFMS) - Central Expenditure Authorization - Public Procurement - GeM, Building Projects - Higher Educational Financial Agency, Utilisation of Public Funds -- TA Rules - General Financial Rules - National Pension System, Record Retention Schedule, Delegation of Financial Powers.

7. Project Management

Project Proposal Management – Intellectual Property Rights - Scholarship/Fellowship Management. They can also cover the management of research projects to be undertaken by the faculty members in addition to various assignments, activities, and projects.

Inter-alia the following topics will be covered within these broad sub-themes:

- 1. Developing leadership qualities at all levels.
- 2. Effective teamwork and collaboration.
- 3. Communication skills for handling interactions with students, faculty, and peers.
- 4. Encouraging continuous learning through workshops, online courses, and certifications.
- 5. Email etiquette and managing online communication.
- 6. Time and Task Management
- 7. Using technology for better task execution.
- 8. Enhancing interpersonal skills for better service to students, faculty, and visitors.
- 9. Conflict resolution and dealing with difficult situations with professionalism.
- 10. Building a service-oriented mindset in line with institutional culture.
- 11. Institutional Ethics and Work Culture
- 12. Understanding and following the institution's code of conduct.
- 13. Developing a sense of ownership and responsibility towards the institution.
- 14. Ethical decision-making in daily work practices.
- 15. Familiarity with digital tools and software relevant to their work.
- 16. Handling institutional data securely and effectively.

- 17. Building career development plans to enhance skills and take on additional responsibilities.
- 18. Emergency response and preparedness.
- 19. Managing physical and mental well-being in a demanding work environment.
- 20. Continuous Learning and Professional Growth

This program would help non-teaching staff enhance their professional effectiveness, which in turn benefits them and their institution.
