Rules and Regulations for the painting competition themed
'Swadeshi Aur Atmanirbhar Bharat'

Theme

- **Swadeshi Aur Atmanirbhar Bharat:** Entries should reflect ideas of self-reliance, indigenous innovation, local craftsmanship and national pride.

Eligibility

- Open to Students of Colleges of University of Delhi

Artwork Specifications

- **Paper size:** A3 (29.7 cm x 42 cm).
- **Mediums allowed:**
 - Drawing: Crayons, color pencils, sketch pens, oil pastels
 - Painting: Watercolors, acrylics, oil paints
- **Digital artwork** is not accepted.

Submission Guidelines

- Only **one entry per participant**
- Artwork must be **original** and not copied from the internet or other sources
- Submit the original copy of Artwork **on or before 26.09.2025** at Gandhi Bhawan.

Restrictions

- Do **not** include:
 - National flags other than India, religious symbols, brand logos, or political content
 - Provocative or inappropriate imagery
- Entries violating copyright laws will be disqualified

Judging Criteria

- Creativity & originality
- Relevance to theme
- Visual impact
- Technique and execution

Other Terms

- By submitting, participants grant organizers i.e. Gandhi Bhawan, University of Delhi, the right to publish the artwork on websites, newsletters and/or social media.
- Once submitted, entries cannot be reused for other competitions, it will be a copyright of Gandhi Bhawan, University of Delhi.
- Jury decision is final and binding.

Result: Result will be declared on 2.10.2025 at 10:00 a.m. at Gandhi Bhawan. The participants (best three entries as judged by the College) are required to attend the event along with the Teacher-in-Charge.

Prizes: Total of five cash prizes with certificates as per following details:

IIIrd - Rs. 1100/-

Consolation 1 – Rs. 501/-

Consolation 2 – Rs. 501/-
