This is in the context of University's Notification Ref.No. DU/Exam/DDC/2025/598 dated 22.12.2025 (enclosed).

The College has uploaded the Internal Assessment (IA), Tutorial (TU) and Practical(PR) on Samarth Portal for all **Undergraduate** and **Postgraduate** programmes. As per the University Notification, the IA and TU marks will be visible on the Samarth Portal, whereas for Practical Marks, students can see if the Practical marks have been N/R-Not Received (Marks not entered) or N/A-Not Applicable (component not define for the course) or AV-Marks Available.

A separate intimation has already been sent on SmartProf. Students are advised to review their marks carefully on the Samarth Portal. In case, there is any discrepancy between the marks uploaded by the Faculty on SmartProf (*also informed on the College Website*) and any marks uploaded on Samarth Portal, students are required to follow the attached process for informing the same immediately for verification and correction in the Admin Office.

It is informed that only matter of discrepancies between SmartProf and Samarth Portal will be taken up. Since Monitoring and Moderation Processes have been already completed, no other grievance will be entertained and will be summarily rejected.

The student has to report such grievances on or before **04.06.2026 by 5:00 PM**, after which no such requests will be entertained.

All students are advised to take note and act accordingly.


