NOTIFICATION

Considering the presence of stray dogs within the College premises and the need to maintain a safe and conducive academic environment, the Competent Authority has decided to **re-affirm** the designated feeding areas. This decision aligns with our fundamental duty enshrined under the Constitution of India along with applicable Animal Welfare Laws and aims to ensure a harmonious coexistence while preserving the academic ambience of the institution.

Students, faculty, and staff who voluntarily wish to feed animals, particularly dogs, must do so only at the following designated locations:

- **Feeder Area 1:** Behind the Boys Hostel and Teachers' Flats, close to Room No. 28.
- **Feeder Area 2:** Near the Porta Cabin next to the State Bank of India.
- **Feeder Area 3:** Near the Staff Quarters area, between Gate No. 4 and the Sports Complex Rear Gate.
- **Feeder Area 4:** Between the two-storey non-teaching staff flats and the Washerman area (Residential Area).
- **Feeder Area 5:** Location of additional feeding area No. 5 is under consideration.

Feeding activities must be strictly confined to these designated areas. Feeding animals outside these zones, including parks, corridors, classrooms, office areas, or other non-designated spaces, is prohibited.

Other points to be kept into consideration are as follows:

1. Vaccination and sterilization initiatives for stray dogs will be supported by the College in coordination with the local civic body.
2. The designated feeder vehicle authorized to distribute food will be allowed to enter from Gate 4 at the specified mutually decided up-till the closest point near the designated feeding spots. Therefore, no separate storage facility is required.
3. Feeding of stray dogs within the residential areas shall be carried out by residents themselves, and entry into residential areas without prior permission is prohibited. Residents are responsible for the care and welfare of stray dogs in their respective areas, which they have already committed to.

4. The recently repaired wall of the erstwhile Hostel Warden's Office-cum-residence shall not be dismantled, as all repair and maintenance activities undertaken are part of infrastructure civil works.
5. Individuals must ensure not to hurt, tease, or harass any animal within the College premises.

This notification **re-iterates** the decisions previously taken during the several interactions/ meetings held between the stakeholders and College Authorities.

Compliance on the above is solicited from all concerned.

This is issued as per directions of the Competent Authority.
