International Conference on AI for Sustainable Economic Growth

Shri Ram College of Commerce, University of Delhi, in collaboration with KPR College of Arts Science and Research (India) and Churchill Institute of Higher Education (Australia), successfully co-hosted the International Conference on AI for Sustainable Economic Growth (ICAISEG 2025).

As a pre-summit event to the India-AI Impact Summit 2026, ICAISEG 2025 witnessed an overwhelming global response with 421 abstracts submitted, 170 research papers presented and participation from 931 contributing authors (790 unique) representing 147 institutions. The conference hosted over 1000 delegates from 8 countries across 4 continents, with a strong global footprint including 134 institutions from India, along with representation from Malaysia, Nigeria, Australia, Canada, Oman, Nepal and Dubai.

We had the distinct honor of receiving gracious felicitations and congratulatory messages from several eminent leaders and dignitaries. These included His Excellency Shri R.N. Online sessions further connected participants from across the globe, ensuring inclusivity and reach.
